

Sleepy Pom Pom Bunny DIY

You will need;

- Black felt
- Pink felt
- White felt
- Brown felt
- Fluffy yarn in different tones
- Pom Pom maker in large, medium & small
- Glue Gun
- Scissors

Directions

Step 1:

Select the yarn color for your bunny. I used the same color for the head and body and white yarn for the tail.

Step 2:

Make a large pom pom for the body and a medium pom pom for the head. When you tie the pom poms off make sure to leave some extra yarn for attaching the pom poms together

Step 3:

Make a small pom pom for a tail. You can make a really small pom pom using a fork. As shown in this video here.

Step 4:

Decide whether you want your bunny standing or sitting and attach the tail and head in the desired position.

Step 5:

Using the template as a guide and your chosen felt cut out the ears, eyes, nose & whiskers.


Step 6:

Using a hot glue gun, glue the inside of the ears to the outside ears. And the nose on top of the whiskers.

Now you're ready to assemble your sleeping bunny.

Decide where you want the ears to go and glue them in place. Now glue the sleepy eyes and nose in place.

Hip Hop Hooray you're done! Bunny is ready for a nap before heading out on an Easter egg hunt.
